In 2013 the TEC funded 198 Private Training Establishments (PTEs) through its Student Achievement Component fund...

.The size and characteristics of PTEs vary. Smaller specialised PTEs may offer a single qualification for fewer than 20 equivalent full-time students (EFTS). The largest PTEs may offer a range of qualifications to over a thousand EFTS. For these reasons comparing PTEs may be difficult.

The government expects PTEs to:

- Work with employers to ensure provision meets employment and industry needs
- Get at-risk young people into a career or further education
- Enable Maori and Pasifika learners to progress from foundation level education to higher levels of learning
- Improve adult literacy and numeracy
