



Infosheet: Post-Study Outcomes information product

This infosheet provides tertiary education organisations (TEOs) with key information about the new *Post-Study Outcomes* information product.

This information product supports our engagement with you on graduate outcomes.

The *Post-Study Outcomes* information product is part of a growing suite of performance tools

In the 2018 Investment Round we released two new Ngā Kete information products on post-study outcomes. These information products were called the *Post-Study Outcomes of Young Graduates* and *Post-Study Outcomes by TEO*.

We have now created a new information product with updated and more up-to-date data as well as improved functionality. The new Ngā Kete information product is called *Post-Study Outcomes* and replaces the previous products.

You can access this new *Post-Study Outcomes* information product via Ngā Kete.

We've significantly enhanced the data

Post-Study Outcomes provides national and TEO-level data about outcomes for graduates by subject area, level of study, age, ethnicity, and gender. Where graduates are in employment, the information product contains data about their earnings.

Enhancements to the data include:

- › a completely new dataset which, for larger qualifications, shows results by NZSCED at individual TEO level
- › improved outcome definitions
- › more information about gender and ethnicity
- › earnings information by Broad, Narrow, and Detailed NZSCED for graduates of all ages, and
- › outcomes one, three, five, seven, and nine years after graduation.

This information product gives you detailed insights into the outcomes of learners' education. The information products enable us to make better, more informed decisions, from a consistent evidence base.

We expect you to use this information about learners' employment outcomes when developing your Plans for funding approval.



Post-Study Outcomes will be used alongside other information

Post-Study Outcomes information provides insights into the benefits of tertiary study measured by employment and income outcomes. We want to reduce our investment in areas with poor post-study outcomes and use this funding for better performing areas.

However, this information will not be considered on its own. We will engage with you first to understand what *Post-Study Outcomes* information tells us about likely outcomes for your learners and why this is the case. These discussions will consider all relevant information.

How to get the most value from our information products

Access to our information products is via Ngā Kete. The information products will be the only way to access your commitments, performance, and delivery data.
