

Thank you for your request, received on 1 July 2019, for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

"...could you please provide me with the figures for the total number and percentage of EPs that included CR types 'uptake and impact' and/or 'outreach and engagement' by individual TEO and within that by Grade (ie A, B, C, CNE) so we can compare which types of TEO had a greater outward focus."

On 18 July you agreed to amend the scope of your request to the following:

"...the proportion of Research Contribution (RC) types of 'outreach and engagement' and 'uptake and impact' in Evidence Portfolios, by TEO type ie ITPs vs Universities."

Please refer to the table below in response to your request:

You may be interested to know that that there was a much wider range in the percentage across ITPs than there was in universities, with the percentage of these types of RCs ranging from 3% to 32% across all ITPs. By contrast the spread was 11 - 15% across universities.
